Dear parents/carers,

As part of the children's music and religious education learning this term, Class 4, 5 and 6 are visiting Lincoln on Monday 2nd March for two very special experiences.

The children are going to have a guided tour of the history and artefacts inside Lincoln Cathedral during the morning, walking down Steep Hill after dinner and enjoying a Music For Youth Primary Prom concert at The New Theatre Royal in the afternoon. We have linked these two visits to save on transport costs.

Your child will need their school uniform, a packed lunch and water bottle in a shoulder bag or rucksack, to carry with them from one venue to another, and a waterproof coat. If your child is entitled to free school meals there is a Cracker and Cheese meal option which can be ordered if you wish to contact The Farm Kitchen.

Our annual out-of-school activity consent form will cover us for this visit but please advise the office staff of any changes to contact information as soon as possible. We are leaving school at 9.30am and returning at 4pm. We will assume that your child will be collected from school or leave unaccompanied as normal. We will walk any children, who go to Kids Club, around to the building on our return. All KS2 after school clubs will be cancelled that afternoon.

Our wonderful PTA and Lincolnshire Music Service have kindly agreed to subsidise the cost of the transport and concert. We are therefore requesting donations of £4 towards the cost of the coaches and guided tour, payable online at School Money or please send donations into school in a named envelope.
