Dear parents and carers,

It has once again been lovely to welcome those of you into school who have been able to meet with your child's class teacher this week. If you have not managed to come into school and would like to arrange a meeting, please contact your child's teacher or the school office. Covid update

Following Government updates this week regarding the number of positive cases which have now reduced, the Director of Public Health for Lincolnshire has revised his advice to schools regarding the thresholds for putting enhanced measures in place, such as reintroducing a 'bubble'. Therefore, **from Monday 24th January, Class 6 will no longer be required to remain in their 'bubble'** and will be able to take part fully in whole school activities such as assemblies, after-school clubs and eating lunch in the hall. Our Year 6 children have been super role models this week, working hard and showing real maturity as they have dealt with changes to their routines. My thanks also go to the staff who have supported the children as they have done a great job returning temporarily to a 'bubble' system and maintaining all the teaching and learning. We look forward to welcoming all those members of our school family back with us as soon as their self-isolation ends.

We will of course be cautious and monitor case numbers and follow any updated advice as it becomes available.

Class 1 parents may return to using the main gate, close to the car park for entering school and Class 6 children may return to entering via the gate alongside the bike shelter. Mrs Hedley will continue unlocking the school gates from 8.50am onwards each morning, ahead of our 9am registration time and locking them at 9.05am once everyone is in school.
