Your child will be given information from their school about being **safe** and **being seen**. Ask them what they have learned.

This term's theme is the important topic of being seen. With the clocks changing and darker evenings, children travelling to and from school are potentially more difficult to see.

Our top tips for Being Bright and Being Seen.....

- * **Accessorize!** Even small items such as stickers and clip on reflectors can improve visibility
- * Make sure your child wears something **fluorescent** by day and **reflective** by night

More top tips.....

- * Choose routes and crossing places that are well lit
- * Cyclists need a clean **red** rear reflector
- * Working lights (**red** at the back and **white** at the front) Only when cycling in the dark
