PE and Sport Premium - End of year report 2016/17

Spend

- £5130 invested in coaching support from JB Sport.
- £3500 invested in coaching support from Carre's Grammar School Outreach.
- £850 invested in PE adviser visits (Matt Evans) to meet with PE co-ordinator.

Headlines

- The school achieved a Gold school games mark.
- We have been shortlisted for the **Active Lincolnshire Primary School of the Year**
- The school entered in to 35 inter-school competitions. Sports included: *Football, Rowing, Equestrian, Netball, Athletics, Table Tennis, Cross Country, Goalball, Gymnastics, Pop Lacrosse, Tag Rugby, Volleyball, Hockey, Orienteering, Cricket, Tennis, Triathlon*
- The school has established The Daily Mile for children, parents and staff

Impact

- 230 opportunities for children in Key Stage 2 to represent the school in inter-school competition
- % of young people in the school are engaged in extra-curricular sporting activity every week.
- 100% of Key Stage 2 children have represented school in inter-school events.
- 74% of SEND participated in extra-curricular sports clubs.
- 42% of service children participated in extracurricular sports clubs.
- 25% of service children participated in inter-school events.

Continued Professional Development

- PE adviser and School Games Organise (Matt Evans), hosted a staff meeting to discuss PE annual plans.
- Sports co-ordinator (Mr Frost) attended the Lincolnshire Sports Partnership PE conference at Bishop Grosseteste University, Lincoln.

Sustainability and Impact

- The school will continue to embed a culture of participation in extracurricular activities.
- Staff have experienced and taught a plethora of sports and skills through the buy-in services of JB's Sports Coaching and Carre's Grammar Outreach.
- Staff have been upskilled on skills based approaches to teaching PE, rather than focussing on a specific sport.

Targets for 2017/18

- To engage more staff in extra-curricular and inter-school sport
- To achieve 'Outstanding' PE for all staff through coach mentoring and sharing good practice across the partnership
- To increase percentage of Pupil Premium children participating in extra-curricular clubs
- To sustain the achievement of the *Gold School Games* mark by continuing to ensure each child receives two hours of PE in their weekly curriculum and pushing the opportunities for children to learn to lead in sport.
