
Key Vocabulary				
Thank you	An expression of gratitude when someone does something for you or gives you something.			
Thankfulness	Feeling or showing gratitude. We are thankful when we are pleased and grateful for what we have.			
Gratitude	Being thankful for things we have. Gratitude is pausing to appreciate things we normally take for granted like food and water.			
Gift	A present or a special talent or ability. You can give things such as time/talent to help others.			
Prayer	A way to communicate with God, often to say "thank you".			
Creator	Many people believe that God created the world we live in.			
The World	The Earth, the planet we live on and everything that lives on it. Psalm 24 v1 says "The earth is the Lord's and everything in it".			
Harvest	To collect what has been planted and grown in the ground. It is usually done by farmers and in the autumn in the UK.
