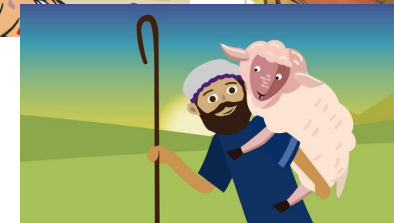


Key Vocabulary

Christian	Somebody who follows the religion Christianity.
Bible	The special book for Christians, which contains stories, prayers and teachings for Christians to learn and follow.
Jesus	God's son, who was sent down to Earth to lead Christians and show them how to live good lives.
humanity	A compassionate, sympathetic and generous disposition (way of behaving). People who have humanity are kind and thoughtful towards others.
prayer	A way of communicating with God to ask for something, praise God, say "Sorry" or say "Thank you".
parable	A story from the Bible that teaches a moral or a lesson. On the surface, the story seems quite simple, but when you dig deeper, there is an important lesson to learn from the characters.
Samaritan	A native or inhabitant of Samaria - from the parable the Good Samaritan.
The Greatest Commandment	A golden rule, that Christians and many other religions live by - to treat others as you wish to be treated.



The Creation Story

Christians believe that God created the world in six days and on the seventh day, he rested. He created man (people) in his own image. The first man was called Adam and the first woman was called Eve. God gave Adam and Eve one rule whilst they lived in the Garden of Eden, but they broke it when the devil disguised himself as a snake and tempted Eve to break the rule. God banished Adam and Eve from the Garden of Eden.
