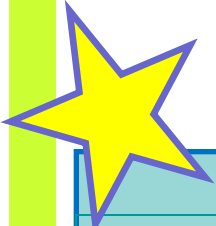

### Lincolnshire children starting primary school or secondary school in September 2026

If your child is starting primary school or transferring to secondary school in September 2026 they may be eligible for school transport.

If you think your child is eligible please apply for transport from 2 March (secondary offer day) or 16 April (primary offer day) once you have your offer of a school place.

## Important please read: Mobile Phones in School

**We discourage all children from bringing mobile phones into school unless they are absolutely essential.**

**You may be entitled to claim extra funding for your child's school and Free School Meals for your children if you are:**

**Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)**

**Income Support**

**Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance**

**Income-related Employment and Support Allowance**

**Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**

**The Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit**

**Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)**

**Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)**


