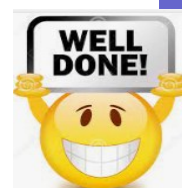

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Holiday Activity Fund (FSM families)

Lincolnshire HAF has moved to a new booking platform, called Eequ. All children and young people who receive benefit-related Free School Meals (FSM) will now be automatically eligible and accepted within the booking system. This means families no longer receive a HAF voucher.

Families can now simply log in to the Eequ platform to browse and book available HAF clubs across Lincolnshire.

New 24/7 Mental Health Crisis Text Service Launches in Lincolnshire

People across Lincolnshire can now access confidential urgent mental health support through a new text service called ChatHealth.

ChatHealth has been developed to support individuals experiencing a mental health crisis and is an extension of the NHS 111 option 2 mental health support provided by the Lincolnshire 111 Mental Health Team. It enables secure two-way messaging between people seeking help and trained healthcare professionals.

Support is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, with the team aiming to respond to messages within two hours.

Two dedicated text numbers are available:

Adults (18+): 07312 263027

Children and young people (under 18): 07480 635303

This service is free; however text messages may be charged at the network's standard rate. Check with the mobile provider for details.

For immediate physical danger or life-threatening emergencies, people should continue to call 999 or attend A&E. ChatHealth is delivered by Lincolnshire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust. For more information, visit www.chathealth.nhs.uk

Free School Meals



You may be entitled to claim extra funding for your child's school and Free School Meals for your children if you are:

Universal Credit- your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Income Support

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
