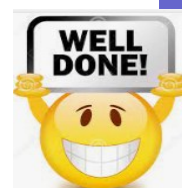

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Holiday Activity Fund (FSM families)

Lincolnshire HAF has moved to a new booking platform, called Eequ. All children and young people who receive benefit-related Free School Meals (FSM) will now be automatically eligible and accepted within the booking system. This means families no longer receive a HAF voucher.

Families can now simply log in to the Eequ platform to browse and book available HAF clubs across Lincolnshire.

This new system is designed to make the booking process quicker, easier, and more accessible for everyone.



If families do not log in to Eequ and create an account, this may delay their ability to book a club when bookings open on 24 June at 11am.

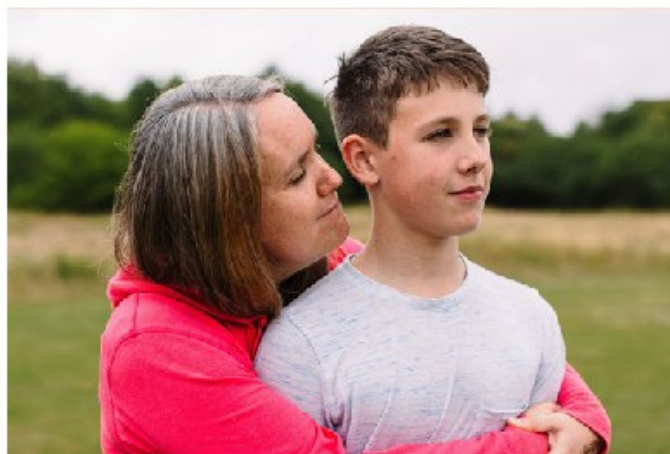

Free School Meals



You may be entitled to claim extra funding for your child's school and Free School Meals for your children if you are:

Universal Credit- your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Income Support

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
