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

## **PE Days: Spring Term**

### **Asthma in schools**

If your child has an asthma diagnosis please can you let school know by providing us with a copy of their current Asthma Action plan/card. If your child requires their inhaler to be in school, please request an 'Administering medication parental consent form' from the school office and return once completed. We require both of these documents to enable us to administer the medication safely. If your child does not have an Asthma Action plan/card these can be collected from school to take to the Doctor's for completion or the Doctor can provide you with one.



We require this documentation for all children who require inhalers whilst in school or during school visits.
