Tattershall Primary School Uniform

Please see listed below a reminder of school uniform requirements for Tattershall Primary.

We have noticed that an increasing number of children are coming into school on PE days with branded tracksuits, various T-shirts and so on.

Please make sure you are aware of the uniform expectations below and ensure your child is wearing items in-line with these expectations.

Most of the items can be purchased at supermarkets, without our school logo, which is perfectly acceptable. All our school uniform is also available to order online from MAPAC. Visit www.mapac.com. If anyone is struggling for uniform, we have a few second-hand items available in school. Please speak to the office staff in confidence if you require some support.

Main Uniform (Summer alternative list can be found on our website)

- * White shirt
- * Royal blue v-neck sweatshirt or Royal blue cardigan/pullover
- * Double stripe Tie for KS2 and elasticated Tie for KS1
- * Grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- * Grey or black trousers
- * Grey, black or white socks
- * Grey or black tights
- * Black shoes - for safety, please ensure shoes have low heels



PE

- * Royal blue T shirt
- * Black shorts
- * Plimsolls or trainers (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 - trainers)
- * Grey, black or dark blue plain jogging bottoms/leggings optional during winter months
- * Grey, black or dark blue plain sweatshirt/fleece optional during winter months

We also have water bottles, book bags and ties available to buy from the school office.
