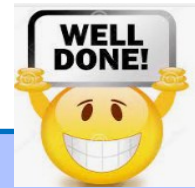

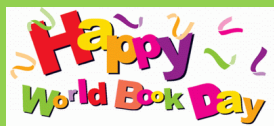

Children moving to another School

Once you have received the offer of a school place we need to know the name of their new school so that records can be sent as soon as possible once they join. We will ask you to complete a Leaver's Form, so that we have a record of where your child is moving to, so that your child does not go missing from education at any point.
