Free School Meals and how to apply

If you claim any benefits, you can find out if your child is eligible for free school meals, whatever their age, by completing a simple check. (Please note this is separate to Universal Free School meals that all KS1 children are entitled to because of their age). HAF Clubs Holiday Activities

Free school meal eligible families can book onto Lincolnshire HAF clubs for the Easter holidays from next week. If your child is eligible for free school meals due to your family receiving benefits to supplement your income you will receive an email with all the information on how to book. How to Book
