Children moving to another School

If your family are moving out of the area and your child will be moving to another school, at any time of the year, it is important that you let the school office know your child's intended leaving date as soon as possible. Once you have received the offer of a school place we need to know the name of their new school so that records can be sent as soon as possible once they join. We will ask you to complete a Leaver's Form, so that we have a record of where your child is moving to, so that your child does not go missing from education at any point. If you have any questions, just ask. We continually have requests for places at our school, which is very positive, but if we know that we will have a place available due to a future house move it helps us let families wanting to join us know in good time.
