UNIFORM

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct school uniform at all times. Uniform requirements have been sent on our bulletins and can be found on our website.

Reminder: Warmer weather

The sun has made a welcome appearance recently and we request that you apply sun cream to your child before school as we go into the Summer months to ensure they are protected up to lunch time when they are outdoors.

You are welcome to send into school named suncream for your child to apply at lunch time so that their skin is protected for the rest of the day.



This will remain in school and teacher's will supervise your child when they apply it. Caps, sunhats and sunglasses with names on can also be brought into school.

Year 6 Transition Days
