## UNIFORM

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct school uniform at all times. Uniform requirements have been sent on our bulletins and can be found on our website.

Please note that cycling shorts are only appropriate school uniform on PE Days, but not for non-PE days.

Black or grey shorts should be appropriate tailored school shorts. All shorts should be of an appropriate length (to the knee).

### Holiday Activity Fund vouchers

All eligible families will receive HAF E-vouchers before for the summer holidays. Please keep an eye out for these via email if your child is eligible for free school meals.

### Warmer weather

With the warmer weather we request that you apply sun cream to your child on days when we have hot sunshine forecast to ensure they are protected when outdoors. You are welcome to send into school named sun cream for your child to re-apply at lunch time or after swimming so that their skin is protected for the whole day. The sun cream will remain in school and teacher's will supervise your child when they apply it. Caps, sunhats and sunglasses with names on can also be brought into school.
