UNIFORM

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct school uniform at all times. Uniform requirements have been sent on our bulletins and can be found on our website.

Please note that cycling shorts are only appropriate school uniform on PE Days, but not for non-PE days. Black or grey shorts should be appropriate tailored school shorts.

All shorts should be of an appropriate length (to the knee).

Sports Day- Tuesday 25th June 9.15am- followed by picnic lunch



We will be hosting our Sports Day on **Tuesday 25th June**, which we are delighted to invite you to attend. Our sports will **start at 9:15am** and you are welcome to come and support your child and join us for a school family outdoor picnic lunch, once our sports events have finished. Families may stay on the field and playground, entering school through the main door if the toilet is required and leave the school grounds by 1pm by the main gate before the children return to class.



To help staff members and races run smoothly we ask that, your child attends Sports Day wearing a plain coloured T-shirt to match their house team. This makes organising the races easier and allows you to easily cheer on house teams. Your child will know what house team they are in; Squirrel Class may not know house team but will certainly know the colour of their team. If a coloured t-shirt is not possible, please send your child in normal blue PE top and we can provide a sticker or a bib to show house team colour. House teams: **Newton - Red, Franklin - Blue, Banks - Green, Tennyson - Yellow** Preschool children are welcome but please ensure they remain in your care.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal, you will be able to order a packed lunch from The Farm Kitchen (these meals will be a packed lunch option only.) You can also pay for a packed lunch for your KS2 child if you wish. Packed lunches will be the only meals available on Tuesday and Friday (Our reserve Sports Day).

If due to adverse weather conditions our Sports Day is postponed, **our reserve date will be Friday 28th June.** The start time will remain the same.

Please make sure your child is wearing PE Kit on Monday 17th June as we will be running a practice Sports Day for the children to become familiar with the events and test their skills. Your child does not need to wear a coloured T-Shirt; normal PE kit will be fine for our practice.
