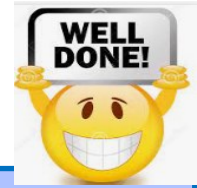

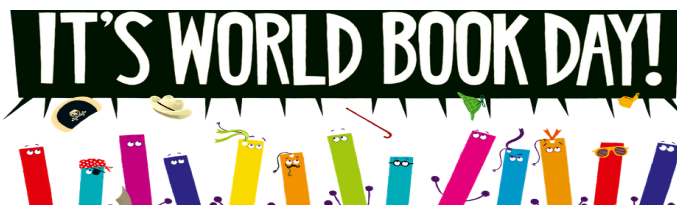
## World Book Day
