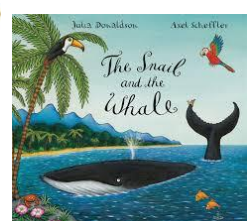
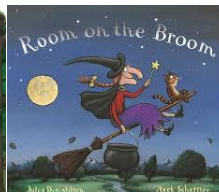
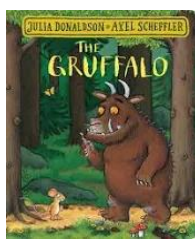
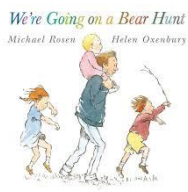
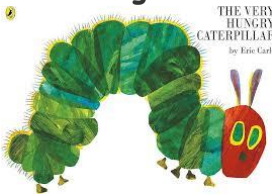
WORLD BOOK DAY - 6th MARCH 2025
