Squirrel Class: The Very Hungry Caterpillar

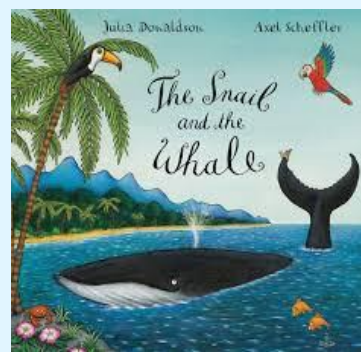
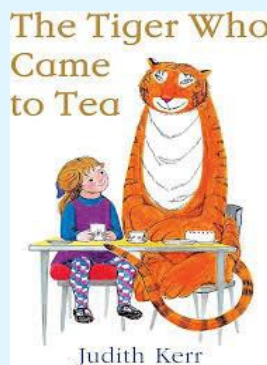
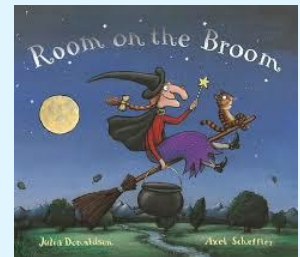
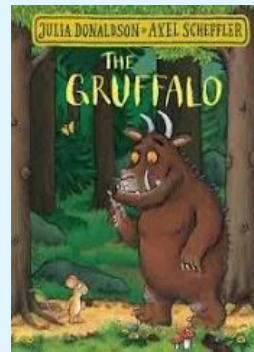
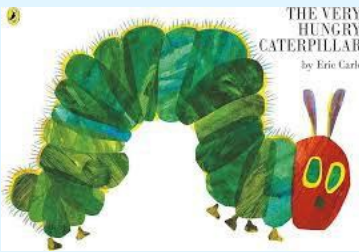
Koala Class: We're Going on a Bear Hunt
