The main changes are:

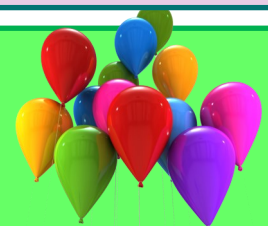
Our Values Champion this week
