### UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS FROM SEPTEMBER

Have you seen the changes to our Uniform policy which will start in September 2025?

The main changes are:

- Squirrels, Koalas and Red Pandas will no longer wear a shirt and tie, but a white polo shirt instead (Alpacas, Lions and Eagles will continue with a shirt and tie as they are now).
