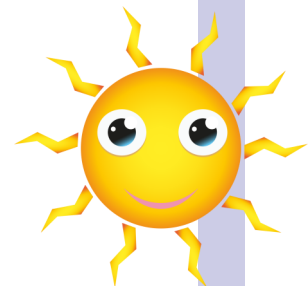

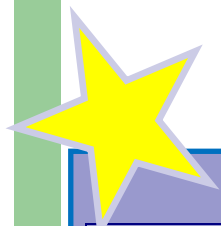

## Thank you and farewell

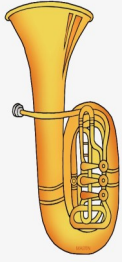

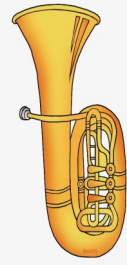
