After School Clubs

After-School Clubs start on the week beginning 26th January. All children joining clubs must be given consent via the Arbor App under Clubs.

Please can we remind parents to pick children up promptly at 4.15pm after each club from our main school office entrance.

If your child did not get a place in a club due to high demand please let us know if you wish your child to go on our reserve lists. Please note: Children who do not attend their club on a regular basis may have their place retracted and offered to a child on our waiting list.

If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and they are able to walk home from a school club you must let us know via the app or by email as soon as possible.

Children will not be allowed to walk home after their club without this permission. Thank you
