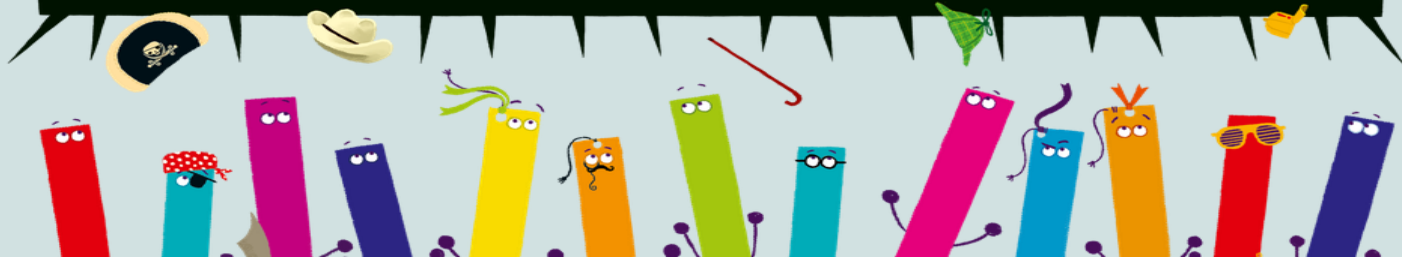

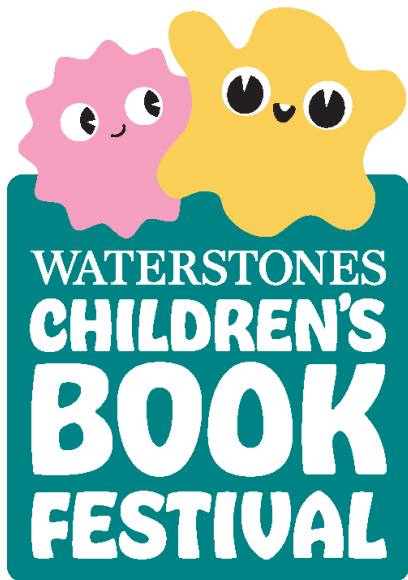
The assembly will provide an opportunity for children to demonstrate their learning, talents, and growth whilst basking in the pride of showcasing their hard work and dedication.
