Our Year 6 children will be doing their SATS assessment during the week beginning **Monday 11th May - Thursday 14th May**

Please ensure your child is in school each day by avoiding making any medical appointments or absence requests during that week.

The tests will take place from **Monday to Thursday**. Each morning the children will complete one or more tests under exam type conditions.

To ensure the children are fully prepared and settled each day we are inviting them to come to school each morning from **8.20am (no earlier)** for a **free breakfast club** where they will be served **tea or squash and toast**. Your child will enter through the main gate entrance and into Eagle Class, where they will be given their breakfast.
