If your child does not get a place onto a club we can place them on our reserve list and notify you if a place becomes available.

### Children moving to another School

If your family are moving out of the area and your child will be moving to another school, at any time of the year, it is important that you let the school office know your child's intended leaving date as soon as possible.

Once you have received the offer of a school place we need to know the name of their new school so that records can be sent as soon as possible once they join.

We will ask you to complete a Leaver's Form, so that we have a record of where your child is moving to, so that your child does not go missing from education at any point.

This information does not apply to our Year 6 children who will all be joining their new secondary school in September.

### Lincolnshire children starting primary school or secondary school in September 2026

If your child is starting primary school or transferring to secondary school in September 2026 they may be eligible for school transport.

If you think your child is eligible please apply for transport from 2 March (secondary offer day) or 16 April (primary offer day) once you have your offer of a school place. **Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)**

**Income Support**

**Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance**

**Income-related Employment and Support Allowance**

**Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**

**The Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit**

**Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)**

**Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)**
