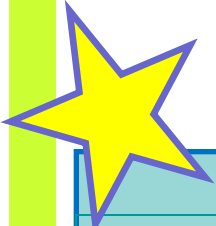

Swimming Lessons Year 4 & 5

Swimming lessons for all Year 4 and 5 children will take place during Terms 5 and 6.

It is a requirement of the National Curriculum that children attain competence in swimming, enabling them to swim confidently and proficiently over a distance of 25 metres while mastering a range of strokes.

By providing swimming lessons at this key stage, we are not only enhancing their water confidence but also working towards meeting these vital curriculum objectives.

You may be entitled to claim extra funding for your child's school and Free School Meals for your children if you are:

Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Income Support

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
